STUDY SESSION ITEMS:

1. **AGS RECYCLING COLLECTION CENTER CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT AT 1128 WEST CHURCH STREET.** Review of a Conditional Use Permit (U2025-0015) for AGS Recycling Inc. to establish a California Redemption Value (CRV) Recycling Center on a 0.39-acre site in a CM (Commercial/Manufacturing) district. The project qualifies for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption pursuant to Section 15301 (Existing Facilities) of the California Environmental Quality Act State Guidelines.

2. **FIGUEROA'S TIRE RETAIL SHOP CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT AT 920 WEST MAIN STREET.** Review of a Conditional Use Permit (U2026-0001) for Jose Jaime Figueroa to conduct tire sales and service in an existing 2,800 sq. ft. building on a 0.17-acre parcel in a PD/C-2 (Planned Development/ General Commercial) zoning district. The project qualifies for a Class 1 Categorical Exemption pursuant to Section 15301 (existing facilities) of the California Environmental Quality Act State Guidelines.

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Note - No decisions are made during the study session. The meeting is an opportunity for the public and the Planning Commission to provide input about projects prior to a future Planning Commission hearing.
