STUDY SESSION ITEMS:

1. <u>DUDLEY-HOFFMAN MORTUARY PLANNED DEVELOPMENT PERMIT AND CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT AT 931 EAST STOWELL ROAD.</u> Review of a Planned Development Permit (PD2023-0020) and Conditional Use Permit (U2023-0020) for Dudley-Hoffman Mortuary to construct a 1,500-square-foot crematory building, and new landscaping and fencing, on a 0.75-acre site in a PD/CPO (Planned Development/ Commercial Professional Office) district.

2. COURTYARD AT HIDDEN PINES PRE-APPLICATION AT 2415 NORTH RAILROAD AVENUE. Review of a Pre-Application (PRE2024-0003) for Dan Patin to develop a mixed-use residential and neighborhood commercial project including six residential townhomes, eight stacked live work units, and approximately 21,045-square-feet of neighborhood-scale commercial development on a 2.8-acre site in a PD/PF (Planned Development/Public Facilities District) of the North Preisker Ranch Specific Plan area.
