**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SANTA MARIA, CALIFORNIA
APPROVING THE 2026 MEETING CALENDAR FOR
CITY COUNCIL AND CITY OF SANTA MARIA
BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, AND COMMITTEES**

WHEREAS, The Brown Act requires that legislative bodies, except for advisory bodies and standing committees, provide the time and place for regular meetings by ordinance, resolution, bylaws, or by whatever other rule is required for the conduct of business by that body. (Gov. Code, sec. 54954, subd. (a).)

WHEREAS, Per City Charter section 2-1.-1 Time, day, and place.

Regular meetings of the City Council shall be held on the first and third Tuesdays of each month at five-thirty (5:30) p.m., or if such regular meeting day shall be a legal holiday, then such meeting shall be held on the next day at five-thirty (5:30) p.m. at the Council Chambers of the City Hall, unless otherwise specified; and

WHEREAS, Boards, Commissions, and Committee meetings are set by resolution and conducted in the same manner as the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA MARIA, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE, AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council and City of Santa Maria Boards, Commissions, and Committees 2026 meeting schedule as shown in Exhibit A of this Resolution is approved.

SECTION 2. All meetings of the local legislative body shall be open to the public, except as permitted by state law. City Council, Block Grants Advisory Committee, Library Board of Trustees, Measure U Citizens' Oversight Committee, Planning Commission, and Recreation and Parks Commission are to meet as indicated in the 2026 regular meeting calendar.

SECTION 3. That the Chief Deputy City Clerk shall certify the passage and adoption of this Resolution and enter it into the book of original Resolutions.

SECTION 4. The Chief Deputy City Clerk is hereby authorized to make minor changes herein to address clerical errors, so long as substantial conformance of the intent of this document is maintained. In doing so, the Chief Deputy City Clerk shall consult with the City Manager and City Attorney concerning any changes deemed necessary.
