

RESOLUTION NO.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SANTA MARIA, CALIFORNIA
ESTABLISHING NO STOPPING ZONES
ON SUEY CROSSING ROAD**

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Santa Maria to establish no stopping zones at certain locations within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Maria Traffic Committee has reviewed and is recommending the establishment of no stopping zones at the locations described below.

WHEREAS, that pursuant to Section 7-5.14 of the Santa Maria Municipal Code, no stopping zones shall be established on the following street, incorporated herein by reference, at the following location by the City Council of the City of Santa Maria, California, as follows:

- **Suey Crossing Road**, along the southwesterly curb face, beginning at the edge of the southeast property driveway of 1670 East Donovan Road and continuing 80 linear feet southwest.
- **Suey Crossing Road**, along the northeasterly curb face, beginning at the edge of the southeast property driveway of 1670 East Donovan Road and continuing 40 linear feet northeast

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Santa Maria, California, as follows:

SECTION 1. The foregoing shall constitute traffic regulations pursuant to ordinance; and

SECTION 2. All work is to be accomplished using the standards and methods approved by the Director of Public Works/City Engineer. This shall be in accordance with standard City specifications, and the provisions of this resolution are to be carried out by erecting signs, painting marks and temporary markers and barricades required, and by such other indicators or devices as may be under provisions of the Vehicle Code of the State of California and regulations adopted pursuant thereto; and

SECTION 3. The Chief Deputy City Clerk is hereby authorized to make minor changes herein to address clerical errors, so long as substantial conformance of the intent of this document is maintained. In doing so, the Chief Deputy City Clerk shall consult with the City Manager and City Attorney concerning any changes deemed necessary.
