

RESOLUTION NO.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF SANTA MARIA, CALIFORNIA
APPROVING THE MEASURE A FIVE-YEAR LOCAL PROGRAM OF
PROJECTS FOR FISCAL YEARS 2026/2027 THROUGH 2030/2031; AND
CERTIFYING THAT THE CITY OF SANTA MARIA WILL PROVIDE
SUFFICIENT FUNDING IN THE 2026/2027 BUDGET TO MEET THE
MEASURE A MAINTENANCE OF EFFORT REQUIREMENT**

WHEREAS, on November 4, 2008, the voters of Santa Barbara County approved Ordinance No. 5, the Road Repair, Traffic Relief, and Transportation Safety Measure, known as Measure A; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Maria held a public hearing per Section 18 of the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Ordinance provides that the Santa Barbara County Local Transportation Authority shall annually approve a Program of Projects (POP) submitted by local jurisdictions identifying those transportation projects eligible to use Measure A funds during the succeeding five-year period; and

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Maria was provided with an estimate of annual Measure A local revenues for 2026/2027 through 2030/2031 to develop a local POP.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Santa Maria, California, as follows:

SECTION 1. The City Council approves the Five-Year POP to be funded in part with Measure A revenues; and

SECTION 2. The City of Santa Maria certifies that it will include in its budget an amount of local discretionary funding for local streets and roads sufficient to comply with Maintenance of Effort requirements contained in Section 27 of the Ordinance; and

SECTION 3. The City of Santa Maria has complied with all other applicable provisions and requirements of the Ordinance; and

SECTION 4. The Chief Deputy City Clerk is hereby authorized to make minor changes herein to address clerical errors, so long as substantial conformance of the intent of this document is maintained. In doing so, the Chief Deputy City Clerk shall consult with the City Manager and City Attorney concerning any changes deemed necessary.
