**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF SANTA MARIA, CALIFORNIA, PROVIDING
AUTHORIZATION FOR THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION
TO STRATEGIC GROWTH COUNCIL COMMUNITY RESILIENCE
CENTERS PROGRAM PROJECT DEVELOPMENT AND
ACCEPTANCE OF AWARD**

WHEREAS, California Strategic Growth Council's (SGC) mission is to build healthy, thriving, and resilient communities for all; and,

WHEREAS, SGC is a 10-member council comprised of seven state agencies and three public members; and,

WHEREAS, SGC provides grant funding to a number of programs benefiting public health, affordable housing and climate change. The SGC Community Resilience Centers Program (CRC) grants fund new construction and upgrades of neighborhood level Resilience Centers to provide shelter and resources during emergencies, as well as year-round programming and services that build community resilience; and,

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works in coordination with the Recreation and Parks Department, has identified the Minami Community Center upgrades and renovations for this grant funding; and,

WHEREAS, the City has the opportunity to receive a grant award in the amount of \$500,000 to \$5 Million to assist with specified project costs.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Santa Maria, California, as follows:

1. Authorizes the submission of a grant application to Strategic Growth Council Community Resilience Centers Program Project Development Grant for award funding amount of \$500,000 to \$5 Million; and
2. Authorizes the City Manager or designee, to execute all forms and documents, and coordinate the implementation of the grant and the awarded project; and approve amending the adopted FY 2024-2025 Budget to reflect receipt of said revenue.
3. The Chief Deputy City Clerk is hereby authorized to make minor changes herein to address clerical errors, so long as substantial conformance of the intent of this document is maintained. In doing so, the Chief Deputy City Clerk shall consult with the City Manager and City Attorney concerning any changes deemed necessary.
